



2009 Dry Creek Valley White Riesling

The 2009 Riesling is a ripe full-flavored, exceptionally easy drinking wine. The absolutely amazing aromas of pineapple, white peaches, lemon-grass. Crisp citrus notes with ripe cantaloupe, a bit of slate minerality rounds out the finish. This wine has a beautiful balance that is crisp and refreshing. This wine pairs seamlessly with Asian, Indian, or Fusion cuisine, and is also the absolutely best wine to sip while cooking or having someone cook for you.

The 2009 vintage was produced from fruit grown on the western Dry Creek Valley. The amazing hillside and benchland vineyards, diverse micro-climates from cool evenings and warm days, allowing the grapes to maintain a balance between acids and sugars, The soil gives the wine slate and mineral flavors for which Riesling grapes are renowned for. Harvested on September 22, 2009, at 24.5 degrees brix, the fruit was whole cluster pressed, and then moved to stainless steel.
